


Including: Shutter Speed/ISO/Aperture



IMG_3759 – Mostly focused on adjusting the colour.

IMG_3753 – Main focus was adjusting colour. Had an issue with my tools – spot healing was not working (Closed the program, reset the tool and tried resetting all tools – still didn't work). So, I could not remove the blue rope in the background.

Information: 1/320 sec. f/7.1 178 mm ISO: 320 (Original)



IMG_ 3716 – Main focus was to bring down the vibrancy – I liked the overall composition of the heart, but the vibrancy was way to extreme. While editing I played around with the gamma correction which helped greatly. Also used brightness, contrast, exposure, vibrancy.

Information: 1/20 sec. f/6.3 160 mm ISO: 500 (Original)






IMG_3665 – The cloudy day made this seem dreary, so I played around with exposure, contrast, brightness and vibrancy.

Information: 1/125 sec. f/6.3 90 mm ISO: 500 (Original)






IMG_3675 – This had the same issue as the one above as they are part of the same sign. Tried to make it brighter and not 'heavily' contrasted.
